

The Hawker 800XP is one of the most successful private jets that British Aerospace has ever made. It is a third-generation model of the 800 series. The cabin of the Hawker 800XP is configured with eight seats: a four-person club section, a three-person divan, and one forward-facing seat. The seats are fully adjustable and can swivel 360°. Different soundproofing options are available, but cabin noise levels usually stay in the low 70-decibel range. One of the Hawker 800XP's strong points is its ability to take off from runways much shorter than are typically required for private jet international flights. The Hawker 800XP does not have any one strong point to make it stand out from the competition. Instead, it has them all, strikes a balance between factors that drive private jet sales – fuel economy, climb and cruise performance, and takeoff distance
